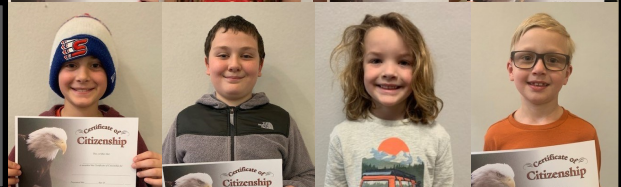

The federal waiver that made school breakfasts and lunches free to every student the past two years is set to expire. 2022-23 we will be returning to our normal breakfast and lunch program in which we will have to charge for those meals unless you qualify for free or reduced priced meals.
