Community Items to Share

All grades:

- 2-3 packages of #2 pencils (preferred brand = Ticonderoga)
- Large eraser
- Fluorescent highlighters
- Package of washable markers
- Package of dry erase markers
- Package of glue sticks
- 1 bottle of liquid glue
- 1 pair of scissors (rounded tip for grades K-4, full-size for grades 5-6)
- Disinfecting wipes
- 1 box of facial tissues
